Installing the AOC Security Certificate

Secure applications require that a certificate be installed to your computer to enable the secure access.

The first step is to type the following address into the address bar of your browser window:

http://www.tncourts.gov/CertSrv

Each time you use a different computer to access a secure site, you will need to install the certificate on that computer. The certificate website will appear similar to:



Click on the **"Download a CA certificate, certificate chain, or CRL**" link one time. This will open the next window:
