ORDER DELAYING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AMENDMENT TO LOCAL RULE 4.01 FROM MAY 1, 2023 UNTIL SEPTEMBER 1, 2023

4.01, Assignment of Criminal Cases, that was to take effect May 1, 2023, be delayed, to take
