### AMENDMENT TO TENN. SUP. CT. R. 32 (effective upon filing of Order)

[Amend Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 32 by deleting the text indicated below by overstriking and by adding the text indicated below by underlining.]

On or before September 1 of each year, the The members of the Court shall, by majority vote, elect a Justice to serve as the Chief Justice. -The term of office for the Chief Justice shall begin on September 1 and be for one (1) year our (4) years with no limit on additional consecutive two-year terms. -A Chief Justice may be removed for good cause upon the vote of four (4three (3) justices.
