


## FRANKLIN

### Dinner at Sportsman's Lodge



Join us for dinner on Thursday, Oct. 22 at the Sportsman's Lodge in Brentwood, TN. For two decades Sportsman's Lodge has been serving up signature dishes that include smoked ribs, hand-breaded catfish, barbecue on Cajun cornbread and a variety of large, fresh salads with dressings made in-house daily.

The building was designed to capture the spirit, style and warmth of the Rocky Mountain National Park lodges built in the early 1900's. The logs were designed and each handcrafted to compliment the rustic style of the building. Logs used in the construction of Sportsman's Lodge are Engleman Spruce from Northwest Montana. The river rock used throughout the building came from the mountain streams of East Tennessee.

The bus will load from the convention center entrance of the Marriott Franklin at 6:00 p.m. (by the registration desk), depart at 6:15 p.m. and the dinner reservation is at 6:30 p.m. Cost is \$10 per person and includes transportation only, as the cost of the meal is on your own. Enjoy!
