**ORDER TEMPORARILY MODIFYING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF
TENNESSEE SUPREME COURT RULE 7 RELATED TO
THE FEBRUARY 2021 BAR EXAMINATION**

Consistent with the Tennessee Supreme Court’s COVID-19 Pandemic Orders entered March 13, 2020, March 25, 2020, April 2, 2020, and May 11, 2020, and in furtherance of the Judicial Branch’s obligation to mitigate the risks associated with COVID-19, the Court cancelled the in-person bar examinations scheduled in 2020 and directed the Board of Law Examiners to administer an online Admissions Assessment on October 5 and 6, 2020.

Applications for the February 2021 Uniform Bar Examination in Tennessee are required to open on October 1, as provided in Section 3.03 of Rule 7. To permit the staff of the Board of Law Examiners to complete administration of the Admissions Assessment, Section 3.03 is temporarily modified and applications for the February 2021 examination will open on October 12, 2020, at 8:00 a.m.

It is so ORDERED.
