ORDER

Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 7, Section 4.03 governs the dates and places of giving the bar examination. The Court has determined that Section 4.03 should be amended to permit the Court to designate alternative sites within each grand division for giving the bar examination. Accordingly, Section 4.03 is hereby amended to read as follows (deleted text indicated by overstriking, and new text indicated by underlining):

Sec. 4.03. The Dates and Places of Giving the Examination. — The examination shall be given in February and July of each year at any one or more of the following places: Memphis, Nashville, Chattanooga and Knoxville, provided an examination is held at least once a year in each of the ~~cities of Memphis, Nashville and Knoxville~~ three grand divisions. The Court, in its discretion, may substitute another location in the same grand division for a city named in the preceding sentence.

This amendment shall take effect upon filing of this order.
