## ORDER OF INTERIM SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Board of Judicial Conduct ("Board") upon notice from District Attorney General Pro Tem Fredrick H. Agee that on December 12, 2023, Judge A. Melissa Boyd, Criminal Court Judge for Shelby County, Tennessee, was indicted on one count of coercion of a witness, a Class D felony, under Tennessee Code Annotated section 39-16-507. In addition, Judge Boyd was indicted on one count of harassment, a Class C misdemeanor, under Tennessee Code Annotated section 39-17-308(a)(2).

Tennessee Code Annotated section 17-5-303(g) provides that upon the filing of an indictment, presentment, or information charging a judge with a felony under the law of any state or under federal law, the Board may immediately place the judge on interim suspension. In this instance, the Board has determined that the public interest and proper administration of justice warrants placing Judge Boyd on interim suspension until further orders of the Board.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Judge Boyd is suspended effective immediately upon the filing of this order. During this term of suspension, Judge Boyd is prohibited from exercising any judicial power or authority, including, but not limited to, holding court, issuing subpoenas, setting or resetting cases, issuing warrants, setting or changing bonds, administrating oaths, or issuing oral or written rulings in any matter. This suspension shall remain effective until further orders of the Board. This Order of Interim Suspension supplements but does not supplant the November 22, 2023, Order Extending Suspension in *In re: Judge A. Melissa Boyd*, No. M2023-00755-BJC-DIS-FC. That Order remains in full force and effect.
