Each candidate must submit the original (unbound) and <u>fourteen (14) copies</u> (stapled or bound and printed on front and back) <u>as well as a digital copy</u> of the Applicant Questionnaire in order to have his/her name placed on the list of candidates for the judicial vacancy for which he/she is applying.
