





























Rule 2.11(C)
Code of Judicial Conduct
(A) A judge shall disqualify himself or herself in any proceeding in which the judge's impartiality might reasonably be questioned, including but not limited to the following circumstances:
(C) A judge subject to disqualification under this Rule, other than for
bias or prejudice under paragraph (A)(1) or for participation in a
judicial settlement conference under paragraph (A)(6)(e), may disclose
on the record the basis of the judge's disqualification and may ask the
parties and their lawyers to consider, outside the presence of the judge
and court personnel, whether to waive disqualification. If, following
the disclosure, the parties and lawyers agree, without participation by
the judge or court personnel, that the judge should not be disqualified,
the judge may participate in the proceeding. The agreement shall be
incorporated into the record of the proceeding.
