GENERAL ORDER REGARDING COURT OPERATIONS

 Long, General Sessions, Division V/Civil Court will not hear cases
 from December 14, 2020 through January 31, 2021.
- 3. Attorneys will notify the Civil Sessions Court Clerk to reschedule cases affected by the court closure December 14, 2020 through January 31, 2021. All resets shall be rescheduled to a date not before

February 8, 2021. Attorneys shall notify all related parties of the new court date.
