CASE LITIGATION PLAN ORDER

Pursuant to Tennessee Civil Procedure Rule 16.02, a Case Litigation Plan Conference was conducted on December 15, 2015. From that, the following order setting pretrial deadlines and setting the case for trial is entered.

- 1. <u>Amendments: Adding Parties</u>—February 26, 2016, is the deadline for amending the pleadings and for adding parties.
- 2. <u>Mediation</u>—By March 11, 2016, Counsel shall file a joint notice stating the date they have a mediation scheduled; or why mediation has not been scheduled. The Court will review that and determine if it shall convene a conference call or hearing on referral by the Court of the case to mediation.
- 3. <u>Written Discovery</u>—On or before April 1, 2016, all written discovery and motions related thereto shall be completed. By agreement of Counsel, initially production

of documents is being exchanged electronically in native format without the requirement of Bates stamping. If a dispute arises regarding the need for Bates stamping, a motion can be filed with the Court.

- 4. <u>Preliminary Dispositive Motions</u>—Motions to Dismiss and For Judgment on the Pleadings shall be filed so as to be heard on or before May 13, 2016.
- 5. <u>Interim Status Conference</u>—On June 24, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., Counsel shall attend a status conference to discuss with the Court the progress and any issues in advancing the case to trial.
- 6. <u>Pretrial Conference</u>—On October 20, 2016, a pretrial conference shall be conducted. Closer to the conference, the Court will set dates for Counsel to file the following:
 - (1) A list of pattern instructions counsel anticipates requesting the Court to provide to the jury at the conclusion of the proof;
 - (2) Proposed jury instructions which vary from the pattern instructions along with citations to statutory or case authority;
 - (3) A proposed verdict form;
 - (4) Motions in limine; and
 - (5) Responses to motions in limine.

7. <u>Trial</u>—A 5-day, 12-person jury trial is set to begin at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, November 14, 2016. For the jury demand to be waived, all parties must consent, and that consent must be filed by October 6, 2016.
