Re: 19th Judicial District Vacancy

Dear Governor Lee:

On May 24, 2024, your office notified the Trial Court Vacancy Commission of the creation of a new judicial position in the 19th Judicial District. After the presiding judge of the 19th Judicial District notified the Commission that this position would be classified as a chancellor, the Commission announced the position on May 24, 2024 and set a June 11, 2024 deadline for submitting applications. The Commission also made arrangements to hold a public hearing on July 18, 2024 in Clarksville.

The application deadline has now passed, and the Commission has received only two applications. The purpose of this letter is to notify you that the Commission cannot provide you with the names of three persons qualified to fill this vacancy as required by Tenn. Code Ann. § 17-4-308(h) because only two persons have applied. Accordingly, Tenn. Code Ann. § 17-4-310(a) permits you to fill the vacancy with any person of your choosing who is duly licensed to practice law and otherwise fully qualified to serve as a chancellor in the 19th Judicial District.

For your information, I have included with this letter the redacted applications of the two persons who filed timely applications for this position. The Administrative Office of the Courts is prepared to provide your staff with unredacted versions of these applications upon request.
