ORDER OF INTERIM SUSPENSION

This cause came on to be considered by the Board of Judicial Conduct on August 10, 2016, upon notice from Disciplinary Counsel that on August 10, 2016, the Campbell County Grand Jury had indicted Amanda Sammons, Judge of the General Sessions Court of Campbell County, Tennessee, for four counts of the Class E felony of Official Misconduct, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §39-16-402(a)(2).

Tenn. Code Ann. §17-5-304(g) provides that upon the filing of an indictment charging a judge with a felony under the law of any state or under federal law, the Board of Judicial Conduct may immediately place the judge on interim suspension. On recommendation of Disciplinary Counsel, the members of the Board were consulted, and by a majority vote of the members of the Board, it was decided that General Sessions Judge Amanda Sammons should be immediately placed on interim suspension.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that General Sessions Judge Amanda Sammons is hereby immediately placed on interim suspension until further order of this Board, and is prohibited during the term of this suspension from exercising any judicial power or authority, including, but not limited to, the holding of court, the setting or resetting of cases, the issuance of warrants or review of affidavits for probable cause, the setting or changing of bonds, the administration of oaths or the issuance of this order.
