A RESOLUTION OF THE MONROE COUNTY, TENNESSEE BAR ASSOCIATION IN OPPOSITION TO REDISTRICTING

MONROE COUNTY OUT OF THE 10<sup>TH</sup> JUDICIAL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated section 16-1-119 required establishment of an

Advisory Task Force of eleven members appointed jointly by the Speaker of the Senate and

Speaker of the House to review the composition of Tennessee's current judicial districts; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Monroe County, Tennessee deserve access to justice and

would be negatively affected by any judicial redistricting that reduces the number of judges

available to serve the citizens of Monroe County and increases the burden on indigent litigants to

access to counsel and the courts; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Bar Association, an association comprised of attorneys

who practice in the Monroe County courts, unanimously oppose any redistricting that would

reduce the number of judges available to serve the citizens of Monroe County and increase the

burden of indigent litigants to access to counsel and the courts by placing Monroe County in a

judicial district outside the 10<sup>th</sup> Judicial District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Monroe County Bar

Association that the Monroe County Bar Association opposes any redistricting that would move

Monroe County out of the 10th Judicial District and reduce the number of judges available to

serve the citizens of Monroe County and increase the burden of indigent litigants to access to

counsel and the courts; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be distributed to the

eleven members of the Advisory Task Force and to all State Representatives and State Senators

representing constituents in the Tenth Judicial District of Tennessee; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a true copy of this Resolution be spread upon its

minutes.
