<sup>2</sup>Oral argument will be limited to the following issues: Whether arrest while on bail for a felony offense, thus requiring consecutive sentences pursuant to TCA Section 40-20-111 and TRCrP 32(c)(3)(C), makes the judgment order running these sentences concurrent void as opposed to voidable (and thus amenable to habeas corpus relief); and if the conviction was void, whether the Court of Criminal Appeals should have remanded the case to the trial court for appointment of counsel and a hearing.
