EXTENSION OF TRAFFIC SCHOOL COMPLIANCE DATES

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

TO: **Richard R. Rooker, Circuit Court Clerk**
Bill Cartwright, Metro Traffic Violations Bureau

Whereas, the President has declared a nationwide state of emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Governor has declared a state of emergency for Tennessee, and the Chief Justice of the State Supreme Court has also declared a state of emergency for the Judicial Branch of Tennessee;

Whereas, General Sessions Court's Traffic School had already cancelled traffic school classes for March 3 in response to the Tornado State of Emergency and for the safety of the Traffic School referrals and the Traffic School instructional staff;

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** that the Administrative Order filed on March 4, 2020 is rescinded and replaced with this order. General Sessions Court shall allow the extension of the Traffic School compliance dates for Traffic School referrals with an original compliance date of March 3, 2020 or after. Such compliance date extension shall be to May 1, 2020. Other compliance date extensions may be considered in the future when severe weather, public health and public safety are concerned.
