AGREED ORDER DISMISSING COUNT ONE OF THE COMPLAINT

As evidenced by their signatures below, the parties hereby agree that Count One of the Complaint is hereby DISMISSED. In support thereof, the parties would show as follows:

1. On July 16th, this Court approved an Agreed Order wherein Count One of the above referenced Complaint was Retired, "to be dismissed in 90 days upon the condition that Judge John Brown certify to the Disciplinary Counsel of the Tennessee Court of the Judiciary that during the retirement period of 90 days, the Honorable Judge Dumas has during that period of time convened court in a timely manner and has regularly conducted her own docket, except for emergencies or other normal absences."
2. The expiration of the 90 day retirement period is October 14, 2010.
3. Disciplinary Counsel has received the required certification from Judge Brown. Said certification is attached as Exhibit A to this Agreed Order.
4. As such, by agreement of the parties, Count One of the Complaint should be DISMISSED.

Complaint is hereby DISMISSED.


