ORDER

On September 28, 2020, this Court published a petition filed by the Nashville Bar Association seeking to amend Rule 21, section 3.01(a) of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court to mandate that each attorney complete two hours of the annual fifteen hours of required continuing legal education in diversity, inclusion, equity, and elimination of bias. We also solicited written comments on the proposal and established December 30, 2020, as the deadline for submitting written comments.

On November 24, 2020, the Tennessee Bar Association (“TBA”) filed a motion requesting a sixty-day extension of the deadline for written comments until March 3, 2021. The TBA requests this extension of time so as to facilitate a full discussion and analysis of the proposed amendment at meetings of its House of Delegates and Board of Governors, scheduled for January 22, 2021, and February 6, 2021, respectively, before submitting its comment.

Upon due consideration, the motion is granted. Therefore, the deadline for written comments is extended until March 3, 2021.

The Clerk shall provide a copy of this Order extending the deadline to LexisNexis and to Thomson Reuters. In addition, this Order shall also be posted on the Court’s website.

It is so ORDERED.
