- Judges are to be ethical, fight injustice and ensure equal access to justice





Tennessee Code of Judicial Conduct


- A judge must be impartial have an absence of bias or prejudice in favor of, or against, particular parties or classes of parties.




Potential Unfairness, Favoritism, Bias

- "Of all the things of a man's soul which he has within him, justice is the greatest good and injustice the greatest evil."



- . [Moore avers] Justice is a universal truth.




Justice is similar to Love True Love is Shown by Action


- July 1960 John Kennedy considers LBJ as VP choice


What determines the perception of justice

- Not necessarily the outcome BUT
- Whether the person was treated with dignity and respect
- Whether the person was given voice
- . Whether the decision maker was neutral and transparent
- Whether the decision maker conveyed trustworthy motives

Court and Life Interruptions A Time to Demonstrate Justice

- . "Take Off Your Robe" Engage the Person as a Person.
- . Look the Person in the Eye
- . Stop and Listen to the $\mathsf{Person}-\mathsf{Don't}$ Show Annoyance
- . Put Other Thoughts and Things Aside for a minute
- Concentrate on that Person
- . Take the Time to Interact and Discuss the Issue
- Help Them if you legally and ethically can assist


Things That Add/Remove Lenses Change/Transform Us

Things That Add/Remove Lenses Change/Transform Us


- Religion seeking God, morality, a sense of right

- Stay Healthy exercise, get rest, eat properly, walk














Paraphrase of 1 Timothy 4:15-16
