Reeves, U.S. District Court</p> <p>Prior to taking the bench, U.S. District Judge Pam Reeves was one of two mediators appointed in December 2012 by Chief Judge Tom Varlan to mediate the property damage issues for over 880 plaintiffs in 63 pending cases arising from the coal ash spill at the Kingston Fossil Plant.
